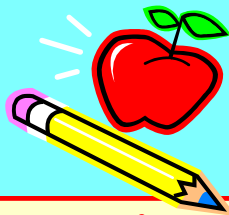

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Subject Summaries

Here is a summary of what we learned in each subject this week:
