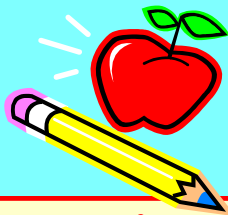

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Subject Summaries

Here is a summary of what we learned in each subject this week:

Math – We continued with multiplication and division this week! It is so important that your child knows his/her math facts, please make sure your child is practicing his/her math facts at home.

Reading – We will be utilizing a new program this year called "Schoolwide" in reading this year. We started to discuss the expectations while discussing literature in small groups while we are reading. Please make sure your child is reading at least 20 minutes each night at home.

Writing – We started a new routine of journaling first thing in the morning. I might put a picture on the board and ask them to tell me about it, or they might be able to choose what they want to write about, then share with the class. Today, they wrote about the expectations in our classroom and what they can do to help their classmate reach those expectations.

Social Studies – We continued talking about the physical environment around us like landforms, natural hazards, natural resources, and climate, and added in comparing and contrasting those attributes for different locations in the US.
